#### **Dear Parents**,

## Please be reminded of the following guidelines when it comes to taking students out of school or class during the school day:

- 1. Advanced Notice: Whenever possible, please inform the school in advance (via the Tyro App) if you need to take your child out during school hours. This allows us to make arrangements and minimise disruption to your child's learning.
- 2. Early Pickup: If you need to pick up your son/daughter early, please (use the Tyro App to inform the office) and sign them out at the front office. You may be required to provide identification for safety purposes.
- 3. Appointments: For medical or other appointments, please use the Tyro App to inform the school in advance to ensure the necessary adjustments are made to your son/daughter's schedule.
- 4. **Minimising Interruptions**: We ask that, whenever possible, appointments be scheduled outside of school hours to avoid disrupting your child's education. Regular attendance is essential for academic success.
- 5. **Explained vs. Unexplained Absences**: If your child needs to leave school early, please remember that it will be counted as an explained absence if it's due to illness, a medical appointment, or another valid reason. All other reasons may be considered unexplained.
- 6. **Returning to Class**: If your son/daughter returns to school later in the day, please ensure they check in at the office to be properly re-entered into their class.

# Please note that a a parent/guardian/appointed person must always present to the office to sign a student out of school.
